Dear parent/guardian,

The Racette curling program will begin Nov. 30, 2021 and run every Tuesday until the end of February 2022. The St. Paul Curling Club is following curling Alberta's lead on the Restrictions Exemption Program (REP). Children do not have to be vaccinated to participate in junior programs, however, coaches will be. Parents will **not** be allowed to enter the curling rink before or after practices. Please ensure that your child does not arrive to practice more than 5 minutes before the start of practice and that they are picked up in a timely manner afterwards.

Practices will be scheduled from 4:00 - 5:15 pm. The fee to participate is \$125 and registration must be completed online at <https://st-paul.curling.io/>

Please note that there may be an additional fee for those attending SPAA. Students must be in grades 7-9 to participate in the SPAA championship. If you are not able to make a practice, please notify Ms. Hlushak.

The focus of our practices will be on skill development, with the opportunity to play a few ends whenever possible. If your child hinders his/her safety, or the safety of others while on the ice, they may be asked to leave the ice surface and watch from the other side of the glass.
